



President's Cup Rules

- Play is governed by USGA & local rules.
- Handicap allowance will be set at 95%.
- Men shall play from the White tee-markers.
- Women shall play from the Red tee-markers.

All matches are to be played on Saturdays. Loss of match if you are not available.

On the tee-box

- Confirm your playing handicap on the scorecard.
- Confirm how many strokes you will give or receive in your match.
- Confirm with your opponent what ball you will be playing.

If match is tied after 18 holes, please play in the following sequence: #1, #18, and #1

Local Rules at CCC

- Hole #9 - Penalty area on the entire right side of the hole defined by red-stakes.
- Holes #12 or #13, if your ball hits a power line, you may get free relief (**no penalty**). Take a drop from the original position and replay your shot.
- If the tower interferes with your swing, you may get relief (Rule 24-2) **OR** you may drop on the drop area near the sign. If the drop area is not marked, take relief (2-club lengths) from the sign near the tower no closer to the hole.
- Hole #15 - Penalty area on the entire left side of the hole defined by red-stakes.

Out-of-Bounds or Lost Ball

- You have **3 minutes** to search for your ball before it becomes lost. Your options are:
 - Go back to the original position of your previous stroke and replay shot under stroke & distance (**1-stroke penalty**).
 - **OR** drop on the fairway (2-club lengths) from the point of entry into out-of-bounds or lost area (**2-stroke penalty**).
- If you think that your ball might be out-of-bounds, please play a provisional to save time. You must **announce** you are playing a provisional before doing so to your playing partner.

Player Instructions after the match

- Sign & attest your scorecard.
- Please ask ruling questions before turning in your scorecards.
- Turn in the scorecard inside the Agave grille.
- Once scorecards are turned in, this will be your final score for the match
