

GREENS COMMITTEE MEETING (Sep 2022)

A meeting was with our GM (Luis Cruz), Head Pro (Derrick Williams), CCC Men's Club President (Eric Wong) & CCC Women's Club President (Ikuko). This is a summary of our meeting:

- Tee-Times will go away from the email system, members are encouraged to use the CCC app on your smart phones, tablet, or computers.
- Inaccurate yardage markers will be corrected by painting on cart paths or placing correct yardages on sprinkler heads.
- Walkway to the 9th White tee-box, thinking of options to fix it due to slip & fall hazard.
- Thoughts & ideas were brought forth to change our pins (flags) into something more prestigious, same colored flags, and a better logo.
- The #1 and #2 greens have been difficult to preserve and have undergone severe damage to the heat & what diseases are cultured with the extreme heat. They are working to save those greens.
- Fairways have dried out due to out dated & broken irrigation systems. The owner has invested (~\$30K) into upgrading this system.
- The tee-boxes have not been able to be cut & prepped properly as a special tee-box mower was out of commission. The parts have arrived after being back ordered & they will start correcting the tee-box conditions.
- Sandpro machine used to rake and toil the sand in the bunkers has been broken. A new Sandpro has been ordered, but due to supply-chain issues won't arrive until November.
- A "welcome pack" was suggested for new members that join teaching new members how to fill a divot, repair a ball mark, rake bunkers, etc. to help improve our course conditions. The new member will also be encouraged to play a round with CCCMA or CCCWA.
- New program was discussed for our current members on how to educate ourselves on how to properly repair ball marks, etc.
- New furniture for the Agave grille will arrive in about (3) months. Planting an herb & vegetable garden next to the 10th tee was suggested & will be considered.
- A member card with a bar code and picture is being suggested to check in. As an alternative, your driver's license may also be used as another idea.
- All guests will need to provide an email and phone number. There may also be limits to guest play to a defined amount of times per year.
- The gate is expected to be operational in a few weeks.
- Two colleges approached Derrick and asked if they could practice here. For now, they were declined though this could change.
- Luis has solicited bids on tee signs. He also suggested they have a greens committee meeting on a monthly basis.
